The gentlemen fourth from the left is Martin Kennelly, 47th Mayor of Chicago, who years earlier served as the 22nd president of the Traffic Club of Chicago. He is being greeted by members of the Club at a reception honoring Mr. Kennelly following his re-election to his second term as Mayor in 1951. Before entering politics Mr. Kennelly was the president of Werner-Kennelly Moving, and the founder and first president of Allied Van Lines, which united local moving & storage companies under a single brand name. Richard J. Daley went on to beat Mr. Kennelly in the 1955 Democratic Primary and the rest is history.

Outside the university he has consulted with governments and leading manufacturing, retail and transportation enterprises around the world. He is the author of many scientific publications and books, and has been recognized in numerous academic and industry forums. He is the recipient of many awards including the Distinguished Service Award by the Council of Logistics Management, the Salzberg Medal and Award for "outstanding leadership and innovations in Supply Chain Management" by the University of Syracuse, and is a life fellow of Cambridge University's Clare Hall College.


